REGARDING LAST PARLIAMENTARY HONOUR TO THE LATE RETIRED SECOND PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA

Hon. Members, As you are aware, the body of the late retired Second President of the Republic of Kenya, H.E. Daniel Toroitich arap Moi, CGH, is laying in-state in Parliament Buildings along the *Speaker's Walk* for the third and final day. In this regard, today's sitting is scheduled to end at exactly 4.45 pm to allow certain steps attendant to the departure of the body of the late retired President to take place by 5 pm.

Arrangements have been put in place to ensure that all Members accord the late retired Second President a befitting parliamentary honour. In this regard, the sequence of events will be as follows-

- **1.** Debate in respect of the motion under Order No. 9, for which the <u>mover</u> has no right of reply, will end <u>at exactly 4.45 pm;</u>
- 2. Immediately after that, the Speaker's Procession will leave the Chamber as usual;
- **3.** Thereafter all Members will leave the Chamber and converge at the main Parliament Gate facing KICC and await the body of the late retired Second President as it exits Parliament Buildings. The Chief Sergeant-at-Arms will guide Members on the designated waiting place;

- 4. The Speaker, the <u>two</u> Leaders of Majority and Minority Party, the <u>two</u> Chief Whips, the Vice-Chairperson of the Parliamentary Service Commission and Clerks-at-the-Table and the Senate leadership will assemble at the Members Lounge;
- **5.** The leadership will thereupon converge at the *Speaker's Walk* to form a procession to escort the casket, together with two representatives of the family and the military team;
- **6.** On arrival of the casket of the late retired President at the Main Gate facing KICC, all Members are requested to await the playing of the National Anthem and the EAC Anthem before the casket is loaded onto the carriage to exit Parliament Buildings;
- **7.** The parliamentary procession will symbolize the House paying its last respect and honouring the late retired Second President for his service to the House.
