MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JOINT PARLIAMENTARY SELECT COMMITTEE ON THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE EAST AFRICAN LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (EALA)

Honourable Members,

- 1 Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41 of the National Assembly, I wish to convey to the House a Message from the Senate regarding the establishment of a Joint Parliamentary Select Committee on the Election of Members to the East African Legislative Assembly (EALA).

 - (vii) Sen. Beatrice Akinyi Oyomo.

- You will recall that, by a resolution made on Thursday, 13th October, 2022, this House appointed seven of its Members to the Joint Committee. The Membership of the National Assembly is led by the Member for Kipipiri Constituency, the Hon. Wanjiku Muhia, MP.
- This means that the **Joint Committee on Election of Members to the East African Legislative Assembly (EALA)** is now **fully constituted** as contemplated by *The East African Legislative Assembly Elections (Election of Members of the Assembly) Rules, 2017.*
- I, therefore, urge the Co-chairpersons of the Joint Committee to urgently proceed to facilitate the process of nomination of Kenya's representatives to East African Legislative Assembly as required by the said *Rules* and keep the House and the public informed on the progress of the matter.
