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1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1. Background and Introduction

The Auditor-General carried out a Special Audit on the efficiency and effectiveness of Covid-19 vaccines roll-out in Kenya. The Audit covered the period from inception of the vaccination exercise in March 2021 to 31 March, 2022. The primary objective of the audit was to determine the efficiency and effectiveness of the Covid-19 vaccines rollout in the Forty-Seven (47) Counties. This report, however, specifically covers the audit performed for the Covid-19 vaccines rollout in Bomet County. The audit involved the review of budget, sources of the vaccines, storage, distribution, utilization and disposal of the vaccines, human resource financing, and coordination of players, monitoring and supervision.

The Government of Kenya commissioned use of the Chanjo System to manage the Covid-19 vaccines rollout and utilized the existing immunization structures for other routine vaccines.

1.2. Audit Scope, Limitations and Mitigation

The audit reviewed all processes relating to Covid-19 vaccines immunization which included budgeting, administration, disposal of the expired stocks, governance, and monitoring structures.

Challenges experienced during the audit included lack of definition of most of the vaccinating facilities in the Chanjo System and inadequacy and incomplete vaccine inventory records. The Audit Team put in place several measures to mitigate the challenges including expanding the scope to near 100% coverage of the vaccinating facilities in the County.

1.3. Audit Approach and Methodology

The Audit exercise entailed planning, piloting of the vaccine roll-out audit in one of the Counties, before rolling out to the rest of the 47 Counties. Meetings were held with the auditee and evidence was collected through interviews, document reviews, data analytics, and analysis of audit evidence, among others. The audit was performed using International Standards of Supreme Auditing Institutions (ISSAIs).

1.4. Report Summary

1.4.1. Doses received and Administered

Bomet County received in total 324,724 doses of various types of vaccines during the period under review. Out of the total of 324,724 Covid-19 Vaccine doses received in the County, a total of 172,829 doses were administered while 18,817 doses were still in stock as at the time of audit. The balance of 133,078 vaccine doses comprised of expired, damaged, wasted and an unexplained deficit variance as at 31 March, 2022.

1.4.2. Budget

A review of the Bomet County health services budget for the 2021/2022 financial year revealed that the County did not budget for the Covid-19 vaccination activities but instead used the budget for routine immunization to cater for the rollout exercise.

1.4.3. Sources and Distribution of Vaccines

The Source of vaccines was from the Government of Kenya (GOK). These vaccines were received in Bomet County through the Nakuru Regional Vaccines Store. The distribution flow was from Regional Store, County stores, and Sub County stores to facilities which administered the vaccines.

1.4.4. Storage of Vaccines

The Bomet County/Sub County stores and facilities to some extent complied with the storage conditions which had been set out for Covid-19 Vaccines. However, weaknesses were noted in the storage facilities including inadequate storage equipment and monitoring tools.

1.4.5. Disposal of Vaccines

The Special Audit noted that a total of 39,409 doses had expired, damaged or wasted. Out of 39,409 doses 28,396 had been disposed together with other hospital waste while 11,013 expired doses had not been returned to the Sub County stores.

1.4.6. Human Resource Matters

The funding for health care personnel was to be carried out by the Government of Kenya, Donors and development partners. Bomet County Management explained that their trainings were undertaken through the assistance of the development partners. However, there was no proper records of documentation maintained for the trainings undertaken or provided.

1.4.7. Coordination of Players

The coordination of the exercise was done by the Bomet County Covid-19 Vaccine Deployment and Vaccination Taskforce. However, the appointment letters and the minutes of the Taskforce were not provided for audit review.

1.4.8. Monitoring and Supervision

The Audit established that Covid-19 Vaccines roll out was monitored and supervised by a Committee to ensure smooth implementation of policies and guidelines issued from time to time by the National Government. However, the Committee did not maintain minutes and attendance schedules to evidence their activities.

1.4.9. Conclusions and Recommendation

The audit concluded that the roll-out of the Covid-19 Vaccines was effective. However, weaknesses were noted in some of the processes, including failure to budget for the rollout activities, practical adherence to waste disposal regulations, inadequate staff and training at the facilities and inadequate access to the Chanjo System due to lack of data bundles for the staff to update information in the Chanjo System. This impacted on the real time recording of information in the Chanjo System and leading to an unexplained variance of 104,582 vaccine doses valued at Kshs.60,577,520 based on the average vaccine cost during the period.

The existing immunization structures for routine vaccines were functional but require scale up to handle unforeseen pandemics. Owing to the weaknesses noted it is recommended that the County Government of Bomet should work closely with the

National Government to strengthen the existing immunization structures and staffing to meet international standards.

2.0 BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTION

Kenya received its first consignment of Astra Zeneca-Oxford Covid-19 vaccine in March 2021 as part of the COVAX facility. This was followed by more vaccines of Moderna, Johnson & Johnson (Janssen), Pfizer and Sinopharm from other development partners. The Ministry of Health (MOH) launched a campaign and kicked off the deployment plan for the Covid-19 vaccines roll out on 5 March, 2021 with priority being given to frontline health workers and essential staff including security personnel. According to the National Covid-19 vaccine deployment plan, the first vaccine plan was developed in March 2021 and was subsequently revised by the MOH in August 2021 in an effort to cover the entire adult population in the country.

Bomet County received its first consignment of Astra Zeneca-Oxford Covid-19 vaccine in March 2021, where a total of 6,200 doses of the vaccine were received from the Nakuru Regional Vaccines Store. They were first administered at Longisa Referral Hospital before being rolled out to the other main facilities in the five (5) Sub County. As at 31 March, 2022, the findings of the Special Audit team were that the County had received a total 324,724 doses as tabulated below:

2.1 Objective of the Audit

The primary objective of the audit was to determine the efficiency and effectiveness of the Covid-19 vaccine rollout in Bomet County. This was achieved through; review of budget, sources of the vaccines, storage, distribution, utilization and disposal of the vaccines, human resource, and coordination of players, monitoring and supervision.

2.2 Terms of Reference

The following Terms of Reference (TOR) guided the Special Audit;

2.3 Scope of the Audit and Limitations

2.3.1 Scope

The audit reviewed all processes from the inception of Covid-19 vaccines roll out, through budgeting to administration and disposal including the governance and monitoring structures. The period covered was from inception in March 2021 to 31 March, 2022.

2.3.2 Limitations

The Special Audit experienced challenges and limitations which were mitigated in several ways in order not to negatively affect the quality and results of the audit findings. The challenges and measures taken included:

- i. The County had 65 facilities defined in Chanjo System while 56 facilities were operating as outreaches and had not been defined in the Chanjo System. This meant they collected vaccines from the nearby facilities defined in Chanjo System. This arrangement at times caused challenges with stock reconciliations. The challenge was mitigated by obtaining the actual number of vaccinating facilities from the Sub County stores and carrying out physical verification of the equipment and stocks in these facilities;
- ii. Vaccine damages and wastages not recorded by the vaccinating facilities. This was mitigated by making reference to the vaccine wastages uploaded in the Chanjo System and collaborating the information with the physical count of the stock;
- iii. Manual records in some facilities were found to be incomplete including those that had not been defined in the Chanjo System. Under such circumstances the Audit Team solely relied on the Chanjo System data which was used as the primary source of data for the management of Covid-19 Vaccines rollout;

- iv. Vaccine stock movements in the Chanjo System indicated that the vaccines received from the Regional Store had all been issued to vaccinating facilities. It was however established that such vaccines were either issued to a Sub County store or were issued to multiple facilities. This was mitigated by undertaking physical vaccines stock counts at the affected stores and facilities and reconciling to the Chanjo System stock movements;
- v. Most of the vaccinating facilities had inadequate staff. This was mitigated by performing desktop work from the Chanjo System before visiting the affected facilities. Further the officer accompanying the Audit Team alerted the officer of the facility to be visited in advance to ensure minimum disruption of essential services during the visit to the facility by the Audit Team; and
- vi. The wet weather conditions and flooding terrain of Bomet County posed a challenge on the transportation of Audit staff to the facilities. The Special Audit relied on the County's contact person to obtain advance information on the condition of the facility to be visited and used the weather forecast data to plan for the best time for the visit.

The Audit Team also had to use data from the forms used for vaccines receipts, utilization and balances at the individual facility while reconciling it with the Chanjo System.

2.4 Audit Approach and Methodology

The Special Audit Team held entry and exit meetings with the County Health Management Team on 9 May, 2022 and 2 June, 2022 respectively. During the entry meeting, uniform and detailed work plans were developed and adopted which were then applied in the execution of the audit. The following were the main evidence gathering methods applied during the audit execution:

2.4.1 Document Review

To effectively plan for the audit and as a source of audit evidence, the Audit Team reviewed various documents including the vaccine order sheets, vaccine stock ledgers, various training reports, outreaches, co-ordination activities and seizure/destruction forms.

2.4.2 Analytical Review

The Audit Team extracted the vaccine data from the Chanjo System and carried comparative analysis with records at the Regional Stores and vaccinating facilities.

2.4.3 Physical Verification

The Audit Team carried out physical verifications in the five (5) Sub County Stores and 119 vaccinating facilities in the County as detailed in **Appendix 1**. Eleven of the facilities were not in Chanjo System.

2.4.4 Interviews

The Audit Team interviewed senior officers from the Bomet County Government to clarify the various issues to assist in making an informed decision as detailed in **Table 2**.

2.5 Audit Phases

The audit was divided into Two Phases; Phase One involved review of processes at The National Treasury, Office of the Controller of Budget and Ministry of Health. It also involved analysis of data maintained in eIMIS, Chanjo System and Kenya Health Information System. The information was then shared with the Audit Teams to inform the next audit phase.

Phase two involved review of processes, data and verifications at Bomet Regional Store, Sub County Stores and the vaccinating facilities in the County. This Phase also involved verification and interview of staff.

2.6 Report Structure

The report should be read in its entirety in order to comprehend fully the approach to and findings of our work. The report has covered analysis and facts as understood with the aim of informing The National Treasury and the Ministry of Health of the status of the Vaccines roll out in the Country bearing in mind the challenges and limitations experienced.

3.0 DETAILED FINDINGS

3.1 Budget and Sources of Vaccines

3.1.1. Unconfirmed Funding of Covid-19 Vaccination Activities

A review of the County's Health Services budget for the 2021/2022 financial year revealed that the County did not budget for the Covid-19 vaccination activities. Covid-19 vaccination costs, including transportation, training and capacity building and procurement of auxiliary services such as syringes and safety boxes could not, therefore, be traced to a specific budget, an indication that they were not budgeted for. This was contrary to Regulations 29. (1) of the Public Finance Management (County Governments) Regulations, 2015 which states that the accounting officer shall ensure that the draft estimates relating to her or his department are prepared in conformity with the Constitution, the Act and these Regulations. Management however, indicated that the expenditures were met by partner organizations, but this was not supported by way of any documentary evidence such as agreements.

The County Government of Bomet indicated that a budget of Kshs.6,265,000 was proposed for service delivery of outreach services. The source of the funds was however not indicated while no documents were provided for audit review to confirm if the budget was funded and actualized.

3.1.2. Sources of Vaccines

The County received 324,724 vaccines between 01 March, 2021 and 31 March, 2022 from the National Government. A review of the County's Health Services Budget for the 2021/2022 financial year revealed that there were no provisions for the Covid-19 vaccine roll out. Further, the Special Audit revealed anomalies in budgeting and funding Covid-19 expenses as summarized in **Table 3** below and detailed in **Appendix 2**:

3.2. Storage of Vaccines

According to World Health Organization (WHO) Guidelines (Covid-19 vaccination: supply and logistics guidance, 12 February, 2021) the Covid-19 vaccines should be stored as follows:

- i. Pfizer should be maintained at -80 °C to -60 °C in Ultra Low Temperatures (ULT) freezer, and for Undiluted thawed vaccine at +2 °C to +8 °C;
- ii. Moderna should be maintained at -25 °C to -15 °C in ULT freezer, and unopened vials can be stored refrigerated between 2 °C to 8 °C for up to 30 days prior to first use;
- iii. Oxford/AstraZeneca should be maintained at 2 °C to 8 °C; and
- iv. Further, Centre for Disease Control (CDC) clinical guidance for Janssen Covid-19 Vaccine recommend storing of the vaccine at temperatures between 2°C and 8°C.

The storage conditions applied to the County Store, Sub County Stores and vaccinating Facilities' Stores.

3.2.1. Storage at the County and Sub County Stores

A review of documents provided for audit and physical verification carried out at the 5 Sub County stores revealed issues as summarized below in **Table 4** and detailed in and detailed in **Appendix 3**.

From the foregoing, the Special Audit Team established that all the five (5) Sub County Stores in Bomet County had adequate security to prevent loss of Covid vaccines as well as prevent unauthorized access. In addition, only one (1) Sub County Store did not have sufficient space for orderly receipt, warehousing, and dispatch of vaccines including a quarantine area for isolation faulty packs and recalled goods. Further, all the five stores did not have a cleaning log completed, signed, and checked by the appropriately designated person, written procedure and a program for pest control and no written procedures for the clean-up of any spillage to ensure the complete removal of any risk of contamination.

3.2.2. Storage at the Facilities Level

A review of documents provided for audit and physical verification carried out at the 119 facilities revealed issues as summarized in **Table 5** below and detailed in **Appendix 4**.

In view of the above, the one hundred and nineteen (119) Covid-19 vaccinating facilities in Bomet County did not have written procedures on sanitation, clean-up of any spillage and no cleaning logs. Further, one facility lacked a contingency plan in case of power failure, equipment breakdown, or cold chain breach.

3.3. Distribution of Vaccines

3.3.1. Distribution at County Level

Documents provided for audit revealed that Covid-19 Vaccines on arriving in the Country ideally should be transferred to the National Vaccine Store (NVS) which in turn distributes

to the Regional Vaccine Stores. The Regional Stores then distributed the vaccines to County Stores which subsequently distributed to Sub County stores and facilities from where the vaccines were administered. However, the distribution model at Bomet County was different as the Sub County stores received the vaccines from the Nakuru Regional Store and then distributed to the facilities at the same time administering the vaccines. In addition, some facilities in Bomet Central and Chepalungu Sub County did not receive vaccines in their own names, but in the name of the Sub County store despite being defined in the Chanjo System.

Out of 324,724 vaccine doses received in Bomet County, a total of 233,893 doses were received at Sub County and 70,936 doses were received at the various facilities as at 31 March, 2022 as summarized in **Table 6** below and detailed in **Appendices 5 and 6**.

According to the National Policy Guidelines on Immunization, 2013, storage and transportation of vaccines and diluents, at all stages of vaccine transportation; a cold chain monitor must always accompany all vaccines whether in cold boxes, vaccine carriers or portable fridges and the temperature reading must be maintained between +2°C and +8°C, including age of conditioned ice packs. Diluents need not be transported at +2°C to +8°C unless they are being transported for outreach activities.

The Special Audit team observed that there was no policy on the mode of distribution for the vaccines and the County used the channels established for normal immunization. Further, there was no budget for incidental costs arising from distribution of vaccines which include fuel, maintenance and allowances.

3.4. Utilization of Vaccines

Ordinarily, Covid-19 vaccines flow through four levels before being administered; National Vaccine Store (NVS), Regional Vaccine Stores (RVS), Sub County Vaccine stores (SCVs) and Health Facilities. Utilization of vaccines including Covid-19 vaccines takes place at vaccinating facility.

Examination of the data maintained in the Chanjo System revealed that 324,724 Covid-19 vaccine doses had been received at the County as at 31 March, 2022. Utilization of vaccines including Covid-19 vaccines takes place at vaccinating facility. Documents provided for audit revealed that there were 65 facilities that had been mapped in the Chanjo System. Analysis of data maintained by the Chanjo System and physical verification revealed that there were 54 vaccinating facilities that were not mapped in the Chanjo System and were sharing log in credentials with the defined facilities.

Out of the total 324,724 Covid-19 Vaccine doses received in the County, a total of 172,829 doses were administered while 18,817 vaccine doses were still in stock as at 31 March, 2022. The balance of 133,078 was either expired, damaged, wasted or unaccounted for as summarized in **Table 7** below or detailed in **Appendix 7**.

3.4.1. Administered Doses

The Chanjo System indicates that a total of 190,583 doses had been administered in the County between 1 March, 2021 and 31 March, 2022. The vaccine doses administered are as tabulated below:

The disparity between the 172,829 doses administered in the trackers which were determined during the Special Audit and the administered doses indicated in the Chanjo System for the same period between 1 March, 2021 and 31 March, 2022 was attributed to retrospective entries of vaccinations in the Chanjo System.

3.4.2. Expired Doses

Vaccine doses totalling to 21,823 had expired as at 31 March, 2022. Out of these doses, 10,810 doses had been disposed by the time of the Special Audit in May 2022 while the balance totalling to 11, 013 had not been returned to the Regional Store.

The Special Audit Team also noted that 1,200 of the expired doses were received at the vaccinating centres when the vaccines were remaining with a useful shelf life of between 7 and 10 days as shown below:

3.4.3. Damaged Doses

These were vaccines that were not administered as the vaccine vials had been damaged. All the 62 damaged vaccine doses in Bomet County had been disposed off by the time of the Special Audit in May 2022.

3.4.4. Wasted Doses

These were vaccine doses that were not administered due to failure to utilize within the stipulated timelines upon opening of the vial. The 17,624 vaccine doses reported as wasted in the County and had been disposed off by the time of the Special Audit in May 2022.

3.4.5. Unexplained Vaccine Variances

Documents provided for audit revealed that 324,724 vaccine doses were received in the County. However, reconciliation of the vaccines received, administered, in stock, expired, damaged and wasted revealed an unexplained variance of 104,582 doses. The following are the weakness observed during the Special Audit that could have contributed to the unexplained variance:

- i. Wastages not reported and recorded at the facilities;
- ii. Vaccines doses utilized during the outreaches or in facilities not defined in the Chanjo System may not have been subsequently updated; and
- iii. Vaccination data was not entered accurately, causing over-administration in some batches and under-administration in others.

3.5. Disposal of Vaccines

The Special Audit noted that a total of 11,013 expired doses were neither disposed nor returned to the Nakuru Regional Store. There were however, no records maintained to record any damages and wastages.

A review of documents provided for audit revealed non-compliance with the disposal requirements as per Section 6.1 of the WHO Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) on waste management of Covid-19 vaccines vials and ancillary supplies. The procedure states that any used or discarded Covid-19 vaccine vials MUST be collected safely and separately from the rest of the waste. Both the empty vials and those with remaining vaccine doses discarded at the end of the daily vaccination activity shall be collected and safely stored until they are collected for final treatment and disposal. These vials should be counted and recorded by the responsible team for the purpose of vaccination activity analysis (e.g.

utilization, coverage, wastage, etc.). Further, Section 6.6 provides that neutralized Covid-19 vaccine vials can be safely disposed in a manner that is not accessible or reusable, and neither being an environmental nor a health threat. The findings on disposal of vaccines are as summarized below in **Table 8** and detailed in **Appendices 8 and 9**.

In the circumstances, the undisposed expired, damaged and wasted vaccines may pose a health risk to general public and the health officers. In addition, failure to follow the disposal protocols may also pose a worse health risk to general public and the Health Care Workers. Further, 108 vaccinating facilities failed to record or account for damaged or wasted vaccines vials in the vaccine inventory report.

3.6. Human Resource Matters

Training at County Level

The Health Care Workers were to be trained and were required to be competent on; knowledge on Covid-19 disease; knowledge and skills in Covid-19 Vaccine demand creation, health facility preparation, safe vaccine administration, infection control practices, patient data management, adverse event reporting and management, documentation and

monitoring of vaccine utilization and logistics, communication, waste management, mental health and multi-disciplinary team work.

Immediately after the Covid-19 vaccines were rolled out, trainings for different levels of personnel in the National and County Governments were conducted. Bomet County Management explained that the training in the County was undertaken through the assistance of Partners. However, no correspondence or documentation regarding donor facilitation and support was provided for audit review to support partnership agreements. In addition, the training plan, training timetable, venue, trainee selection criteria, training timetable, venue and training reports were not provided for audit review.

Further, as observed during the field visit to the facilities, the number of Health care Workers trained was low or were actively involved in other activities hence affecting speedy rollout of the vaccination program.

A review of the documents provided for audit revealed anomalies as summarized below and detailed in **Appendices 10 and 11**.

In the foregoing, the Special Audit Team could not establish the adequacy of Human Resources engagement in the Covid-19 vaccines roll out programme.

3.7. Coordination of Players

Coordination at County Level

According to the National Covid-19 Vaccine Deployment Plan 2021, the County Emergency Covid-19 Response Committee was to be adopted to form the Steering Committee. A review of documents provided for audit at the Counties, Sub County and Facilities revealed anomalies as summarized below and detailed in **Appendices 12 and 13**.

From the foregoing, all the Sub County which had a co-ordination task force did not have any documentation on the Terms of Reference, thus it was not possible to establish compliance.

3.8. Monitoring and Supervision

Monitoring and Supervision at the County and Facilities Level

A review of documents provided for audit at the various levels of Covid-19 management revealed anomalies as summarized in **Table 11** below and detailed in **Appendices 14 and 15**.

In view of the above, 19 vaccinating facilities failed to monitor temperatures during transportation while 3 facilities did not update the temperature monitoring charts every morning and evening. Hence it was not possible to ascertain deviations beyond the acceptable standards temperatures set by WHO. Further, all the 5 Sub County and 61 facilities had received tablets from the MOH for use in the recording on vaccine receipts and administration. Of the 61 facilities, 40 facilities reported their tablets as faulty. The 5 Sub County and the 41 facilities reported not having received the monthly airtime.

Consequently, there was inconsistency in the release of the monthly airtime for the tablets in the facilities and the Sub County.

4.0 IRREGULARITIES AND WEAKNESSES IN MANAGEMENT AND CONTROLS OF VACCINES IN INSTITUTIONS

The following are irregularities and weaknesses observed at the Bomet County and Sub County levels and the corresponding recommendations made by the Special Audit;



5.0 CONCLUSION

The objective of the Special Audit was to determine the efficiency and effectiveness of the Covid-19 vaccine roll out in Bomet County. Following the findings, the County should ensure that all vaccinating facilities are defined in the Chanjo System and effective supervision of the activities at the County, Sub County and facilities on all matters relating to vaccines receipts, issues and administration of the vaccines. This impacted on the real time recording of information in the system and an unexplained deficit variance 104,582 of vaccine doses valued at Kshs.60,577,520.

The County should also adhere to the cold chain and supply logistics guidelines as issued by WHO and MOH. In order to meet the increasing service demands, there is need to continuously assess demand for health workers and build their capacity for effective service delivery to the citizens of Bomet County.
