## REGARDING RESUMPTION OF SITTINGS FOR THE THIRD PART OF THE SESSION

## Honourable Members,

- I wish to welcome you back to the House for the Third and final Part of the Second Session of this House. It is my hope that, in the course of undertaking your parliamentary duties at the constituencies, you managed to take some rest and also spent quality time with your families. I am also optimistic that you are re-energized and ready to transact business of the House.
- 2. **Honourable Members**, you may recall that on Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023, I notified the House that from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> to Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023, the Leadership of the House was scheduled to hold a retreat under the *theme* "Building Synergy in Leadership: Enhancing the Legislative Agenda in the National Assembly."

Among other Resolutions, the Leadership resolved to reconfigure certain aspects of Question Time with a view to enhancing effectiveness of legislative oversight through parliamentary Questions.

To this end, the retreat resolved that action be taken to enhance the National Assembly's budget, particularly in Committees, so as to avail adequate resources for execution of the constitutional trusts bestowed on the National Assembly.
- **6.** Finally, **Honourable Members**, let me wish all of you success in your individual capacities as Members and collectively as a House throughout this final Part of the Second Session.
