ON APPOINTMENT OF SENATORS TO THE MEDIATION COMMITTEE ON THE PUBLIC FINANCE MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 16 OF 2023)

Honourable Members,

- 1. You may recall that during the Morning Sitting of Thursday, 14th September 2023, the House <u>rejected</u> Senate Amendments to the <u>Public Finance Management (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 16 of 2023)</u>. This decision essentially remitted the Bill to a Mediation Committee in accordance with Article 112 of the Constitution and Standing Order 149.
- 2. Honourable Members, you may further recall that, during the afternoon sitting on the same day, I notified the House that I had nominated seven Members of this House to represent the National Assembly in the Mediation Committee on the Bill. I also designated the Deputy Leader of the Majority Party, Hon. Owen Baya, CBS, MP, to Co-Chair the Committee.
- **3. Honourable Members,** having conveyed the decision to the Senate, I wish to inform the House that the Senate has now nominated the following Senators to the Mediation Committee
 - (i) Sen. (Dr.) Steve Ltumbesi Lelegwe, MP;

- (ii) Sen. Johnes Mwasheshe Mwaruma, MP;
- (iii) Sen. (Dr.) Oburu Oginga, MP;
- (iv) Sen. Peris Pesi Tobiko, MP;
- (v) Sen. Beth Kalunda Syengo, MP; and
- (vi) Sen. Wahome Wamatangi, MP.
- **4. Honourable Members,** now that the Mediation Committee is fully constituted, I urge the Hon. Owen Baya, CBS, MP, who is the Co-Chairperson of the Mediation Committee, to reach out to the Senate counterparts with a view to commencing the mediation process in accordance with Article 113 of the Constitution. The Clerk is hereby directed to facilitate the Committee.
- **5.** The House is accordingly guided.
