APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO A MEDIATION COMMITTEE ON THE EMPLOYMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL (SENATE BILLS NO. 10 OF 2022)

Honourable Members,

- 1. You may recall that on Tuesday 5th March 2024, the House <u>rejected</u> a Motion for the Second Reading of the Employment (Amendment) Bill (Senate Bills No. 10 of 2022). The National Assembly's rejection of the said Bill essentially remitted the Bill to a mediation committee in line with Standing Order 149(1)(b).
- 2. Honourable Members, Article 113 of the Constitution contemplates that whenever a Bill is referred to a mediation committee, the Speakers of the Houses of Parliament shall appoint an equal number of Members from both Houses to attempt to develop a version of the Bill for consideration by the Houses of Parliament.
- 3. In this regard, having consulted with the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, I have appointed the following Members to represent the National Assembly in the Mediation Committee to consider the Bill—

- (i) The Hon. Eric Muchangi, MP Co-Chairperson
- (ii) The Hon. Gitonga Murugara, CBS, MP;
- (iii) The Hon. Mary Emaase, MP;
- (iv) The Hon. Lilian Siyoi, MP;
- (v) The Hon. (Dr.) Wilberforce Oundo, MP;
- (vi) The Hon. Irene Mayaka, MP; and
- (vii) The Hon. Ruth Odinga, MP.
- 4. For clarity, Honourable Members, the Mediation Committee will be fully constituted upon appointment of Senators to the Committee. Once I receive a Message from the Senate to that effect, I will convey the same to the House.
- **5.** Thereafter, the Mediation Committee will embark on an attempt to develop a mediated version of the Bill in accordance to Article 113 of the Constitution for consideration by the Houses of Parliament.
- **6.** The House is accordingly guided.
