5. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Speaker issued the following Communication –

Variance in the Global Figure on FY 2025/2026 Budget Estimates for Recurrent and Development Expenditure

“Honourable Members,

As you will note in today’s Order Paper, the House is scheduled to resume debate on the Motion on the consideration of the Budget Estimates for the financial year 2025/2026. The conclusion of this will pave the way for the consideration of the Estimates in Committee of Supply pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 240. As earlier directed, this will be undertaken on Tuesday, 10th June 2025, on a priority basis.

Honourable Members, I wish to notify the House that, as will be noted in the Supplementary Order Paper, there is a variance on the global figure being sought to be issued from the Consolidated Fund, between the Notice of Motion as issued and as currently contained in the Supplementary Order Paper. This variance has been occasioned by a reconciliation of the figures against the various votes contained in the First Schedule to the Supplementary Order Paper. The correct figure is **Ksh. 2,538,593,978,440.00.**

The motion will therefore be considered with the corrected figure, which is indeed published in the Supplementary Order Paper.

The House is accordingly informed. I thank you!”

- (iii) orders that **“The Speaker do now leave the Chair”** to facilitate the consideration of the said Budget Estimates with respect to each Vote and Programme in the *Committee of Supply* as contemplated under Standing Order 240 (*Consideration of Estimates in the Committee of Supply*).
