**THE DEMISE OF NOMINATED MEMBER, THE LATE HON. DENAR  
JOSEPH HAMISI, MP**

**Honourable Members,**

- 1.** It is with profound sorrow that I hereby notify the House and the entire Parliamentary fraternity of the untimely demise of Nominated Member, the late **Hon. Denar Joseph Hamisi, MP** who passed on today, Saturday, 6<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at about 7:00am.
- 2.** The late Hon. Denar was nominated to the National Assembly following the 2022 General Elections under the Amani National Congress (ANC) Party. Until his untimely demise, the late Hon. Denar served the National Assembly with diligence and commitment as a Member of the **Departmental Committee on Sports & Culture** and the **Select Committee on National Cohesion & Equal Opportunities**.
- 3.** **Hon. Denar Joseph Hamisi, MP** was born in 1969 in Kinango and attended Mombasa Baptist High School between 1984 and 1989 where he sat for his Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (KACE) and Kenya Certificate of Education (KCE) Examinations. He later pursued further studies at various institutions including United States International University (USIU) for Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management (2000) and Masters in International Business Administration (MIBA) (2002); and the University of Nairobi for a Bachelor of Laws Degree (2006).

4. Prior to joining Parliament, the Hon. Denar held various positions both in the private and public sectors. Within the public service, the late Hon. Denar served as Director, Coast Development Authority (2007-2010); Commissioner, Electoral Commission of Kenya (ECK) (2007-2008); Director, Kenya Airports Authority (2009-2012); Director, Kenya National Accreditation Services (2011-2012); Council Member, the University of Nairobi Council (2013-2018); and Council Member, Moi University Council (2021-2022). He will be fondly remembered for humility, and steadfast commitment to service to the nation. His passing is a great loss not only to the House but also to the nation at large.
5. On behalf of all Members and staff of the National Assembly, and indeed on my own behalf, I convey the heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of the late Hon. Denar, and to all those who experienced his humility and steadfastness to service to the nation and the community.
6. As we come to terms with passing on of our colleague, I have appointed Members to liaise with the family and coordinate a befitting send-off for the Late Hon. Denar. The team will be led by the Deputy Leader of the Majority Party, the **Hon. Owen Baya Yaa, CBS, MP.**
7. Further details on the matter will be communicated in due course.
