MESSAGES FROM THE EXECUTIVE

(No. 001 of 2026)

Honourable Members,

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 42(4), I wish to report to the House that I have received a Message from the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury and Economic Planning regarding the nomination of persons for appointment to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board.
2. In the Message, the Cabinet Secretary conveys that, in exercise of powers conferred to him by section 15(1)(e) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, Cap.414A, he nominates the following persons for appointment to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board—
 - (i) **Ms. Komora Yvonne Nsunsu;**
 - (ii) **Ms. Manyanga Vyonne Boyani;**
 - (iii) **Mr. Mutua Fidelis Kiketi; and**
 - (iv) **Mr. Morris Putita Kaaka.**
3. The Cabinet Secretary now seeks the approval of the National Assembly as required under section 15(1)(e) and (4) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, Cap.414A.

4. **Honourable Members**, Standing Order 45 provides that, upon receipt of notification of a nomination for appointment, such nomination shall stand committed to the relevant Committee for consideration. In this regard, I hereby refer the Message from the Cabinet Secretary, together with the curriculum vitae, and other testimonials of the nominees to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Committee for consideration.
5. **Honourable Members**, the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, Cap.414A **does not** prescribe the period for the approval of nominees to the Board by the National Assembly. However, section 8 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, Cap 7F provides that, unless otherwise provided in law, a Committee to which such nomination is referred shall consider the matter and table a report in the House **within twenty-eight (28) days**.
6. The Committee is therefore required to immediately commence the approval process and notify the nominees and the general public of the time and place for holding the approval hearings and thereafter, table its report to enable the House to consider the matter within the set statutory timelines.
7. The House is accordingly guided.
