1. The House assembled at Thirty Minutes past Nine O'clock.
2. The Proceedings were opened with Prayer.
3. **Presiding** – the First Chairperson of Committees.

8. MOTION – CONSIDERATION OF THE BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2026/2027

(General Debate – 1st Allotted Day)

Motion made and Question proposed –

THAT, this House **adopts** the Report of the Budget and Appropriations Committee on its consideration of the Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure and the Medium Term for the Financial Year 2026/2027, *laid on the Table of the House on Tuesday, 2nd June 2026*, and pursuant to the provisions of Article 221 of the Constitution, section 39 of the Public Finance Management Act, Cap. 412A and Standing Order 239—

- (i) approves the issuance of a sum of Kshs. **2,930,216,013,184** from the Consolidated Fund to meet the expenditure during the year ending 30th June 2027 in respect of the Votes contained in the First Schedule to the Order Paper, subject to paragraph (iii) *(Committee of Supply)*;
- (ii) makes the policy and financial resolutions contained in the Second and Third Schedules to the Order Paper; and
- (iii) orders that **“The Speaker do now leave the Chair”** to facilitate the consideration of the said Budget Estimates with respect to each Vote and Programme in the *Committee of Supply* as contemplated under Standing Order 240 *(Consideration of Estimates in the Committee of Supply)*.
