4. **MESSAGE**

The Speaker reported the following Message—

Message on Passage of the County Governments Additional Allocations Bill (Senate Bill No. 8 of 2026)

“Honourable Members, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41(4), I wish to report to the House that I have received a Message from the Senate regarding the County Governments Additional Allocations Bill (Senate Bill No. 8 of 2026).

Honourable Members, the Message conveys that the Senate considered and passed the County Governments Additional Allocations Bill (Senate Bill No. 8 of 2026) on 17th June 2026, **with amendments**. The County Governments Additional Allocations Bill (Senate Bill No. 8 of 2026) was published *vide* Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 61 of 16th March 2026 and seeks to provide for additional allocations to county governments for the 2026/2027 financial year and the responsibilities of National Government and county governments pursuant to the said allocations. Having passed the Bill, the Senate now seeks the concurrence of the National Assembly on the Bill in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(4) of the Constitution.

Honourable Members, Standing Order 143 (1) requires the Speaker to cause a Bill received from the Senate to be read a First Time upon conveyance of its Message. I therefore direct the Clerk to have the Bill listed in the Order Paper for the First Reading at the next sitting. Thereafter, the Bill stands committed to the **Budget and Appropriations Committee** for consideration pursuant to the provisions of Article 110 of the Constitution. The Committee is to report to the House on the Bill, to enable its consideration within the set timelines. The House is accordingly guided. I thank you.”
